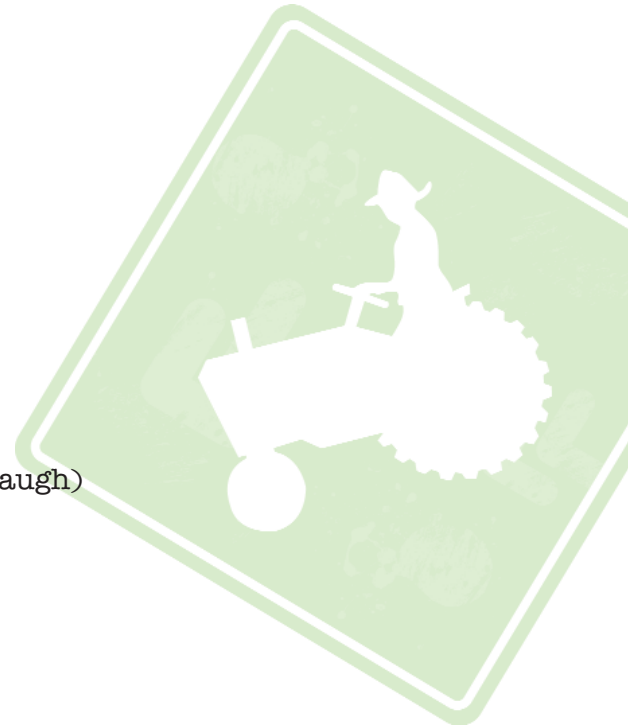


# personality and values worksheet
