

Have you defaulted on your student loan?

If you've defaulted on an education loan and want to receive additional financial aid to return to college, you must first be in a satisfactory repayment status or successful in rehabilitating your loan(s).

Contact VSAC and ask for instructions on ways either to meet a satisfactory repayment status or to rehabilitate your loan(s). If your loan is owned by another company, or if you don't know which company owns your loan(s), start by contacting the company that bills you for payments.

You will be required to take steps to place your defaulted loan(s) back into a satisfactory repayment status or to resolve your default status completely.

Once you've either taken the necessary steps to place your account in a satisfactory repayment status or you've rehabilitated your defaulted loan(s), you'll be eligible to apply for additional education loans from the federal government.
